### PROFILE:

Wolfgang Tschapellers practice is based in Vienna. He was born in the town of Dölsach in East Tyrol, concluded an apprenticeship as a carpenter, and studied architecture at the University of Applied Arts in Vienna and at Cornell University, Ithaca, N.Y. Wolfgang Tschapeller has been a visiting professor at Cornell University, N.Y., at the University of Arts in Linz and the State University of New York in Buffalo, as well as other academic institutions. In 2004/2005, he was the McHale Fellow at the State University of New York in Buffalo, and since 2005, he has been professor of architecture at the Academy of Fine Arts in Vienna.

His major projects include the BVA1, 2 and 3 series for the building of the Austrian Insurance Fund for Public Employees, the hotel in the park of the Schwarzenberg Palais in Vienna, and the European Cultural Centre situated between the Palatine Chapel and the city hall in Aachen, as well as his projects for the Music Theatre in Linz. The administrative building of the municipal authority in Murau, (2002), and the house St. Joseph (2007) integrates and embodies his essential considerations and ideas.

Wolfgang Tschapeller's projects have been shown, for instance, 2010 in Istanbul, 2008 in Tokyo, 2010., 2006 and 2004 at the Architecture Biennial in Venice, 2006 in China within „Sculptural Architecture in Austria“, at the Aedes West gallery in 2004 and at the Architecture Biennial in Sao Paolo in 2003.
