SEHAN YOON, HAEAHN ARCHITECTURE, FIRST PRIZE

A Korean team, led by Sehan Yoon, is winner of the international competition for the masterplan of the new central government administration town, on an area of 2 700 000m², in the province of Chungcheongnam, in the Republic of Korea.

Entitled **Flat City-Link City-Zero City**, the project proposes a flat city as an **alternative to the high-density vertical modern city**; a link city where everyone has an equal chance of leading a happy urban life with all physical and philosophical urban components **linked together**; a zero city which **emulates nature's efficiency** to reduce waste and save energy.



This project, destined to become **a symbol of 21st century Korea**, an exemplary and sustainable realisation, is part of a vast planning process that aims to create a **balance between growth and development** in the Republic of Korea.

Launched by the Multi-functional Administrative City Construction Agency (**MACCA**) and the Korea Land Corporation (**KLC**), this single stage competition was approved by the International Union of Architects.
